## FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

This action came on for final hearing on February 25, 2004 upon Petition for Dissolution of Marriage. The court, having reviewed the file and heard the testimony of Reynaldo Pena, finds and decides as follows:

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.

- 4. There is one minor child of this marriage and the wife is not pregnant.

Said agreement was freely entered into by both parties after full disclosure and is in the best interest of the parties. The Marital Settlement Agreement is approved

and incorporated into this judgment and the parties are ordered to comply with same.

- 6. The marriage between Petitioner/Husband, REYNALDO SILVIO PENA and Respondent/Wife, CARMEN PENA, is dissolved because it is irretrievably broken.
- As agreed, the primary physical residence of the minor child REYNALDO PENA, JR. born on April 26, 1988 shall be with the Respondent.
- 8. As agreed, the parties shall share parental responsibility.
- As agreed, the Petitioner shall have visitation as specified in the marital
  Settlement Agreement.
- 10. The Respondent has filed her Answer, Waiver, and Request for Copy of Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage and therefore the Order of Default previously entered by the Court is hereby vacated.
- 11. The Court reserves jurisdiction to enforce this Judgement.
