**ORDER ON PETITIONER'S MOTION TO VACATE FINAL JUDGMENT OF  
DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE AND ORDER ON REPORT AND  
RECOMMENDATION OF GENERAL MAGISTRATE ON WIFE'S PETITION  
FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE AND HUSBAND'S COUNTER-  
PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on the Former Wife's Motion to Vacate Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage and Order on Report and Recommendation of General Magistrate on Wife's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and Husband's Counter-Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, filed on June 6, 2022. Having considered the Court filings, evidence, and being fully advised, the Court hereby FINDS and ORDERS as follows;

1. On October 13, 2021, this case came before the Court upon the Wife's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and Husband's Counter-Petition for Dissolution of Marriage. On May 26, 2022, the Magistrate's Report and Recommendation was filed.
2. The parties did not waive exceptions, and the Court's Report included the requirement that a party seeking review of the report "shall be by exceptions. See Rule 12.490(f)."
3. That Rule was amended effective April 1, 2022, but given the instructions per the Report, the Former Wife/Petitioner filed Exceptions to the Report and Recommendation on June 6, 2022. This filing was timely made under Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.514.


4. However, the same day the Former Wife filed her Exceptions, the Court's Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage and Order on Report and Recommendations of General Magistrate on Wife's Petition for Dissolution of marriage and Husbands Counter-Petition for Dissolution of Marriage was entered on June 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:27am by the court. This was within the ten days allowed for filing exceptions.

5. Wife's counsel is ordered to contact the undersigned's judicial assistant to schedule an exception hearing.

6. The party who submitted this proposed order to the Court for approval is required to serve a copy of the signed order upon any persons not registered to receive service via the e-portal.
