FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE BY AFFIDAVIT

THIS MATTER came before the Court upon the Husband's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and Other Relief filed October 26, 2023, the Wife's Answer and Counter-Petition filed December 26, 2023, and the Husband's Answer to Wife's Counter-Petition filed January 17, 2024, and the Court having reviewed the file, having received evidence and testimony, and the Court being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it hereby FINDS, ORDERS and ADJUDGES as follows:

- 1. **Nature of Proceeding:** This is a proceeding to dissolve the parties' marriage and for related relief. There are no minor or dependent children of the marriage and the Wife is not pregnant.
- 2. **Jurisdiction and Venue:** The Husband and Wife have been residents of the State of Florida for at least the six months immediately preceding the date of filing this action. The Husband and Wife last resided together in Broward County, Florida. Neither is a member of the United States armed forces or the armed forces of any other jurisdiction. Accordingly, this Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties to this proceeding.
- 3. **Dissolution of Marriage:** The court finds that the parties' marriage is irretrievably broken. Thus, the bonds of marriage between ROBERT L. PEREZ and VIOLET M. PEREZ are hereby

dissolved, a vinculo matrimonii, and each is restored to the status of being single and unmarried.

4. **Settlement Agreement:** The parties voluntarily, and with the intent to be bound, entered

into a settlement agreement that resolves all issues in dispute between them. The parties' Marital

Settlement Agreement dated May 3, 2024, was separately filed with the court on May 6, 2024. The

Court ratifies, approves and incorporates by reference, but does not merge, into this Final Judgment, the

parties' Marital Settlement Agreement, and orders each party to timely comply with all of the terms and

conditions thereof.

5. Reservation of Jurisdiction: The Court retains jurisdiction over the parties and the

subject matter of this proceeding to enforce the terms and conditions of this Final Judgment, the

Marital Settlement Agreement, to adjudicate and enforce all claims of attorneys' charging lien(s), and

for all other purposes permitted by law.
