The Settlement Agreement entered by and into between the parties hereto on or about the 22nd day of May, 2019 (copy attached as Exhibit 1), together with the Parenting Plan (copy attached as Exhibit 2), Child Support Addendum (copy attached as Exhibit 3) and Child Support Worksheet (copy attached as Exhibit 3A), are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of this Final Judgment and Decree of Divorce, and both parties are hereby ORDERED to comply with the terms thereof.

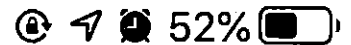

Petitioner shall have and receive immediate and exclusive use, possession and title to the 2003 Honda Odyssey. Petitioner shall be responsible for paying any debt associated with such vehicle and shall indemnify and hold Respondent harmless for the same.

6.

Respondent shall have and receive immediate and exclusive use, possession and title to the 2006 Toyota Camry. Respondent shall be responsible for paying any debt associated with such vehicle and shall indemnify and hold Petitioner harmless for the same.

7.

Petitioner shall receive seventy percent (70%) of Respondent's Compshare account no. C*****5142 and shall receive seventy percent (70%) of all retirement accounts owned by Respondent. Petitioner shall receive fifty percent (50%) of all non-retirement brokerage or stock accounts (including, but not limited to, Compshare account no. C*****5199) owned by the parties or by Respondent. Petitioner shall have and receive all accounts titled solely in her name, including all bank accounts. Except as otherwise set forth above, Respondent shall have and receive all accounts titled solely in his name, including all bank accounts. To the extent that the parties have any other joint accounts that are not otherwise addressed herein, such accounts shall be split evenly between Petitioner and Respondent.

The parties agree that they have adequately and equitably divided their personal property.
