FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on the Husband's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage with Minor Child and Related Relief and Wife's Amended Counter-Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and Other Relief, and the Court having taken testimony, and after reviewing the Court file, makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.
2. The Husband has been a continuous resident of the State of Florida for more than six (6) months immediately prior to the filing of the Verified Petition for Dissolution of Marriage with Minor Child and Related Relief.
3. The parties were married to each other on January 16, 2016, in Miami-Dade County, Florida.
4. There is one (1) minor child born of this marriage, to wit: Mackenzie Alexandra Revell, a female child born on May 16, 2017. The Wife is not pregnant.
5. This Court has jurisdiction over the minor child:

- a. The United States is the country of habitual residence of the child.
 - b. The State of Florida maintains the most significant contacts with the child and is the most appropriate forum for addressing parenting contact.
 - c. The State of Florida is the children's home state for purposes of the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act and the Parental Kidnapping Prevention Act.
 - d. Venue is proper in Miami-Dade County.
 - e. The requirements of the International Child Abduction Remedies Act and the Convention on the Civil Aspects of International Child Abduction enacted at the Hague on October 25, 1980 are met.
6. The Wife wishes to restore her name to her maiden name **MONICA SUZANNE FERNANDEZ**. No money judgments have been entered against the Wife, and the Wife has never been adjudicated bankrupt, nor is she seeking a name change for ulterior legal motive.
 7. The parties have entered into a Marital Settlement Agreement and Parenting Plan on August 20, 2024, which resolves all of the parties' issues including child related matters, equitable distribution, alimony and attorney's fees. The Court finds that the Marital Settlement Agreement was entered into freely and voluntarily by the parties.
 8. The marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken.

THEREFORE, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. The Marital Settlement Agreement and Parenting Plan entered by the parties on August 20, 2024, is hereby ratified. The parties shall comply with all of its provisions. Notwithstanding incorporation of the Marital Settlement Agreement and Parenting Plan into this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage, said agreement shall independently survive same.

2. The Wife's name shall be restored to her maiden name: **MONICA SUZANNE FERNANDEZ**.

3. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter herein.

4. The Court orders that the marriage of the parties be dissolved a *vinculo matrimonii*, as the marriage is irretrievably broken.

5. The Court reserves jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter herein.

6. The Court reserves jurisdiction to enforce or modify the terms of the Marital Settlement Agreement and Parenting Plan and the Final Judgment, and to provide such other and further relief as the Court may deem necessary and in the parties' child's best interest.
